



OVERVIEW

AIM OF NIASA:

The aim of the Association is to represent the Nuclear Industry in South Africa and to support, promote and champion the collective interests of its members.

Objectives:

- (a) To act as a public voice for the nuclear industry
- (b) To actively promote the maximum local industrialisation and economic clustering of nuclear manufacturing in South Africa
- (c) To promote excellence and a culture of safety and security within the industry (d) To promote skills development, job creation and Black Economic Empowerment through the nuclear industry in South Africa
- (d) To facilitate coherence and to avoid duplication of effort in the development and expansion of the nuclear industry
- (e) To promote public understanding of nuclear technology
- (f) To act as a sounding board to Government on policy formulation
- (g) To promote a common approach to research and related scientific issues and the role of universities
- (h) To facilitate the solution of problems or obstacles faced by the industry.

Since NIASA will attempt to represent the interests of the entire nuclear industry in South Africa, various sub-committees that focus on the interests of specific areas will be constituted as the needs for these initiatives become clear.

Membership:

Membership is reserved for organisations and individuals as defined below that subscribe to the aims of the Association. Membership will be open to participants from any country. South African-based subsidiaries of international companies or organisations may seek membership of either the international or the local or both companies/organisations

Member companies/organisations must nominate principal members and secundi to represent their organisations at Annual or Special General Meetings. Secundi may attend meetings with principal representatives but may only vote when the particular principal member is not present. Any employee of a member organisation may however attend all the functions and activities of the Association subject to the conditions that apply to any specific function or activity.

The following membership categories and membership fees have been approved:

- a) **Sponsor members (for a member that pays an annual sponsorship to the Association of R114 000.00).** Sponsor members obtain a seat on the Board of the Association in addition to the elected Board members. Sponsor members may further nominate two [2] representatives and two [2] secundi to represent their organisations at Annual or Special General Meetings.
- b) **Large Corporate members (for companies with a South African turnover in excess of R100 million).** Large Corporate members may nominate two [2] representatives and two [2] secundi to represent their organisations at Annual or Special General Meetings. Annual membership fee **R34 200.00.**
- c) **Intermediate Corporate members (for companies with a South African turnover between R30 million and R100 million).** Intermediate Corporate members may nominate one [1] representative and one [1] secundus to represent their organisations at Annual or Special General Meetings. Annual membership fee **R22 800.00**
- d) **Small Corporate members (for companies with a South African turnover between R10 million and R30 million).** Small Corporate members may nominate one [1] representative and one [1] secundus to represent their organisations at Annual or Special General Meetings. Annual membership fee **R11 400.00**
- e) **Associate members (reserved for societies/associations with a South African turnover less than R10 million).** Associate members may nominate one [1] representative and one [1] secundus to represent their organisations at Annual or Special General Meetings. Annual membership fee **R1 140.00**
- f) **Academic Institutions.** Academic members may nominate one [1] representative and one [1] secundus to represent their organisations at Annual or Special General Meetings. Annual membership fee **R 5 700.00**
- g) **Professional members** (individuals such as consultants that are professionally engaged in the nuclear industry that would not otherwise have access to membership). Individual members may not nominate a secundus. Annual membership fee **R1 140.00**

Since any employee of a member company/organisation may attend all the functions and activities of the Association, it is necessary for such employees that wish to participate in the activities of NIASA to fill in the attached application form for **Individual Employees** in order that the information can be captured on the database.

Membership will be open to participants from any country. South African-based subsidiaries of international companies or organisations may seek membership of either the international or the local or both companies/organisations.
